



Tesla Engineering Charter School Scholarships

The purpose of Tesla Engineering Charter School scholarships is to reward, acknowledge, and encourage those students who have clearly demonstrated passion and ability in technical areas consistent with core engineering principles.

Appleton Area School District's Tesla Engineering Charter School Charter Board will award several scholarships of \$1,000 each on behalf of Tesla business and industry sponsors at the 2017 Tesla Graduation Ceremony in May. The scholarship can be used for tuition, books, course fees, and housing.

Applicants must:

1. Be a graduating senior of the Tesla Engineering Charter School.
2. Be enrolled in an accredited university.
3. Be in pursuit of a degree in welding, electrical, mechanical, chemical, civil/structural, software, or robotic engineering in a technical or engineering school.
4. Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher (on 4.0 scale).
5. Have a minimum SAT score of 1000 and/or ACT score of 21.
6. Have demonstrated the pursuit of technical interests beyond the classroom.
7. Submit a typed/electronically completed application to the board. **Handwritten applications will not be accepted.**

Process and deadline

The Appleton Area School District's Tesla Engineering Charter School Charter Board will evaluate applications in April. Each applicant will be notified of the final decision after May 1st. Scholarship funds will be available to the student beginning in the fall semester. A complete scholarship application must be **postmarked by the deadline of April 15, 2017.**
